Semi Formal Attire Dress code:

Ladies: The ladies attire is modest: knee length (2” below fingertips) or floor length dresses or gowns. No plunging necklines or midriff showing. No see-through fabric where undergarments would normally be seen. Spagetti straps and strapless dresses are allowed.

Gentlemen: Gentlemen’s attire is expected to be dress shirts, dress pants and ties. Jackets are optional. Shirts should be buttoned modestly (no more than 1-2 unbuttoned). No underwear should be exposed.

Conduct: All participant’s actions while at the dance will be polite, well behaved, and honoring to Christ, whether dancing or on the side lines of the dance floor. There will be no vulgar language or inappropriate dance movements. In the event that the participant chooses to disregard this standard and the chaperones feel it is necessary to intervene, the parents will be called to take the student home. Any student who leaves the building for any reason may not return to the event, and their parents will be called.

If the attendee arrives at the door and it is determined they are inappropriately dressed, they will be asked to return to the event when they have made the appropriate changes to their attire. The decision of appropriateness is left to the sole discretion of the event committee chairperson. If an attendee is asked to leave and return because of the dress code and their decision is to not return, there will not be a refund of fees.

Mill Creek Country Club dress code: The following items are not considered suitable attire: cut offs, tank tops, strapless tops (excluding dresses), bare midriffs, t-shirts without collars, athletic shorts, sweatpants and torn denim. This applies for all who are on the Country Club premises even for drop-offs and pick-ups.

Parents: This event will be well chaperoned. You may pick up your teen in the lobby. The dance will end at 11:00pm and your teen will meet you in the lobby area. Please be aware that your teen will be photographed and a link to all photos will be emailed out to the guests. Photography will be by Rebecca Calvo Photography. For free downloading of the photos, roll your mouse over the bottom right corner of the photo on screen and a download option will appear.

FYI This event is designed to be an evening specifically for teens. This means the music and dancing may be different from what some parents find enjoyable; however, this event is to be a wholesome opportunity for our young people to interact. We will have a professional music system and DJ with only clean lyrics. We will have a variety of music played including pop, rock, Christian and swing. There will be some slow music played. All dancing is to be tasteful. Chaperones will intercede any inappropriate dancing to help make the night more enjoyable for all those attending.
